In Sweden we celebrate WQD this year on **November 11th**.

World Quality Day (WQD) has been organised in Sweden since 1990 by the Swedish Association for Quality. WQD was founded in 1989 when the European Organization for Quality, the American Society for Quality and the Union of Japanese Scientists and Engineers agreed on a joint event for quality and business development. It was also decided that the conference would continue to be held annually on the second Thursday in November.

The WQD provides both inspiration and practical advice on quality and business development.

The theme for this year's WQD is highly topical: "**Agile management systems – in a fast-moving reality**" The starting point is that in all organizations there are systems for managing the business. But how systematic, effective, sustainable and value-creating are these systems? Are they agile and adapted to a rapidly changing world? Or is it really the job of the management system to be agile? Shouldn't it rather be stable? And does the management system guarantee the quality of goods and services? These are some of the questions that will be addressed during the conference. One of the keynote speakers will be **Henrik Eriksson**, author of the book **Sweden's Best Operations**. Take the opportunity to learn from Henrik and the other speakers' research, experiences and insights.
